Boston Rally In
9th Falls Short;
Cards Win, 4-3

ST. LOUIS, June 3. (AP)—Weathering a two-run rally in the ninth inning, the St. Louis Cardinals opened a 4 to 3 victory over the Boston Braves here last night.

Mort Cooper had allowed the Braves only six scattered hits in the first eight runs until the ninth. Ernie Lombardi had led off the ninth. Mac West struck out but then Frank Demaree singled sharply to left, moving Mac, who ran for Lombardi, to second. Boston's Bill then slapped a triple right, scoring both runners and putting the tying run on third. That was the end of Cooper and John Beasley, one of the Cardinals ace relief hurlers, came in to stop the fireworks but it was well a needle throw by Eddie Slaughter that possibly saved the game.

Jim Tobin, the Boston pitcher, sent a fly to Slaughter in right field and he pegged the ball home with enough speed to hold Bill at third. Holmes then tapped his shortstop Marty Marion for the final out.

Each team put over a run in the first inning, the Braves on two hits and the Cardinals when the first three men up smashed out singles. Marion singled with the bases loaded to score two runs in the ninth and Harry Walker singled in the other run in the seventh.

Both teams passed up

hard-popped cut with the bases filled for Boston in the third and George Kurkowski failed twice with the bases loaded for the third out.
