Bernard Baruch and Henry Wallace have locked horns again. It seems that Mr. Wallace is up to his old tricks of publishing false statements, according to Mr. Baruch.

Santa Claus gets one fifth of his Christmas trees from Montana, and most of them from Lincoln and Flathead Counties in that state. For several years now, two to three million trees have been cut and shipped from that region.

The trees are shipped to all parts of the country, some going as far away as Maine, a state proud of its own Christmas tree crops. The western foresters think their trees do not shed needles as readily as trees grown in other sections.

These trees that gladden so many children on Christmas morning are not depleting forests. They are treated as crops and others are coming along after them from the same land where these stood.

The 4-H clubs not only provide recreation and a wholesome atmosphere but also help to train the girls and boys in everyday activities, in leadership and in good citizenship.
