**Senators Told Labor Trouble Result Of Law**  
Wagner Act Blamed By Attorney For Present Unrest; Taft Is Optimistic

WASHINGTON, Jan. 29.—(AP)—A New York attorney, Theodore Iserman, told the Senate Labor Committee today that, in his opinion, the Wagner Act is "the root of unsatisfactory labor relations in the United States." He endorsed proposed legislation by Republican Senator Joseph Ball of Minnesota to revise the Wagner Act.

An optimistic view on labor legislation in the senate was voiced today by Chairman Robert Taft of the Labor Committee. The Ohio Republican said that his committee and the administration may be closer together on a measure to curb labor strife than it first appeared.
