


 Americans Credited Russians Apply



German propagands support a task of the prejudices of every group, seeking to se labor against capital, Christian against Jew, black against

The United States Office of Facts and Figures rewals that among the untruths currently being spread through-out the United States by agents and thoughtless persons used as their unwitting tools, are the following: 1. Democracy is dying.

2. Our armed forces are weak. 3. The "new order" is inevitable.

4. We are lost in the Pacific.

5. Our west coast is in such grave danger there is no point in fighting on. 6. The British are decadent and "sold us a bill of goods." 7. The cost of war will hunkrup; the nation. 3. Civillan sacrifices will be more than we can bear.

Not only would it divide the United States into numerous warring factions, but it would also divide the United Nations into hostlie instead of friendly allies. It succeeded in dividing France and England and now it tells the British that America is willing to fight to the last drop of English blood. And it tells America that we are trying to pull England's chestnuts out of the fire.


