Indeed. who are Crisitanl. Simpeon and Noble?


They are the lant thre winners of Academy Awarda for best film rdiling - Cristlana for "The Last Emperor," Simpson for "Platoon" and Noble for "Witnesa."
They are members of perhape the moat important group of aritsis in movies who labor anonymoundy in small dark rooms ellher standing at movieolas or hunched over KEM ediling machines monotonously solng over thousands of feet of film. splieing. culling. Juxtapoing the work of their directorn.
Movleolas are complex machines that project the film on a tiny 4-by-5-inch screen. clatiering along with the wound blaring. The new Keim is an aluminum complex of spools, eprockets and threadIng knobs that also projecte on a small sereen. Both have cutting devices to make nplices.
The better the edtior. the beller the motion pieture.
Often top movies become nominated for best picture of the year because of their editors. Yet their names are as unfamillar to moviegoers ats the names of newspaper editors to readers.

A handful of film edtors hive gone on to become internatlonally renown directors. Robert Wisc. Mark Robson. Fred Zinnemann. Hal Ashby and David Lean among them.

One of the most neted editors in recent years was the late Verna Fields who was credited with saving director Steven Spiclberg's "Jaws" from the ecrap heap. Fields won the Oecas in 1975 and later became a viee president of Unlveraal Pictures.
She was the studto's heroine when she berllitantly asaembled tons of foutage sent to her from Splelberg's locatons on the Eust Coast during production.

Dante eventuatly hired him to coed ll "Ptrunha," foltowed by a job ediling Dante's "The Howling." In ION 1 Goldblatt edited "Hallowern II" and he was on his way.
He has worked for such other directore and producers as James Cameron. J. Lee Thompson. Joel Silver and Larry Gurdon.
Like thousands of other crafismen In Hollywood. Goldblatl once aspired to actIng. A mative New Yorker, he allended the Universily of Wlaconsin and The London Film School, where he deeded he would rather direct than act.

"Hut the power ts mindbogeling. An editor ts enirumed wilh thousinds and thousands of feet of film and the is expected to follow the director's vision in puiting il together to make the terat movir ponalble.

He also has power over stars and actors. An editor can make a good actor look better or worse, and the same fur bad actors.
"It ts all a mater of his cholesen of which 'take' to une. when to cut from one actor to another or Intersperse shots effectively to create the sort of feeling the director wanta from ascenc.
"We no through each day': work one frame at a lime. running a scene through the moverola scorms of times, marking the film as we go. It ts olten repelitive.
The editing process begina on the flrst day of production when the expomed filan comes back from lite lab and is deposiled In the edilor's lap.
He musl agree with the difector's overview of the film. understand lis poimi of view and phtlosophle concept. While the directur may duve the final rut, it ts the editor whe lias the first cut, a fact of wheh all editors are proud.
The director then poes abou shooling a day's work, often priniling dazens of shots or takes of a single sene master shot. Iwo-shots close-ups, over-Ihe-shoulders. revernes - and a hundred other varietles of camera angles and polnts of view.
Thuse shois that are printed are shown the next day ustally durlong the juschit Lreak In a small studio projection room - to the director, edtor. cameraman. actors. and often one of the producers. Showlags of the raw footase, once called "rushes." loday are known as '"dailles."
fer during the screnting of the disjointed, unconnected Dim. relying on the clapper board with its scene rand shot number for reference.
The editor takes notes on the director's preferences. The director also listens to hls edtior's sukkestons regarding addittonal shooling.
When the director relums io the set to resume shooling. the editor finds himself cuting the datly footage, following the director's preferences but also making his own contributions. Some directurs almost cut their film in the camera becatse thelr shots are so precise. Thry know exacily what they want and find It unaccesary to shool excess footage. They can expose as lifite an 40,000 lect of 11 mm . Oihers shoot an much as 250.000 feel or more for a fealure fllm. Some have gone as high a million feet.
'I'd say the average director shools 15 or 20 fect of film for
every foot used in the Inal print." Goldblatt sald. "The avernge film runs aboul 110 minutes or approximately 10,000 feel.'
That means the editner is up to his epiglotits in reels and reels of tilm that will be discarded. If he is working with a perfecifiontst who prinis lake after take of, say. a closeup of an actor reading a dozen lines of dlalogue, the Iofl becomes enormous.
Moot ediltors work with two asslstants and an apprentice on a film. necessitated by the diminishing lead itme beiwern the end of production and release of the firilshed prodiact.

The more Dim a difretor shoots. the better the selection for the edtior.' Goldblatl sald.
Certalnly, It ts better for an editor to be given too nuwh sim than too litile.
It is not uncommon for an editor to find one acrene followtng another without a trassitonal shat to bind the two tagether.
