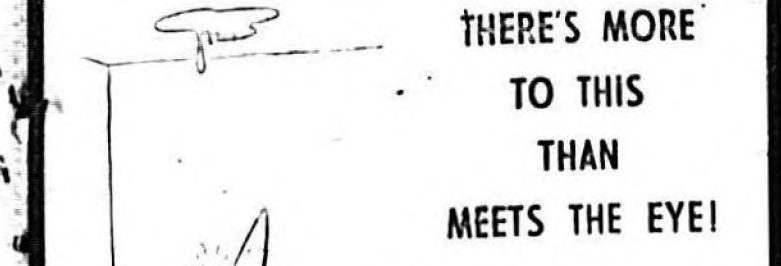

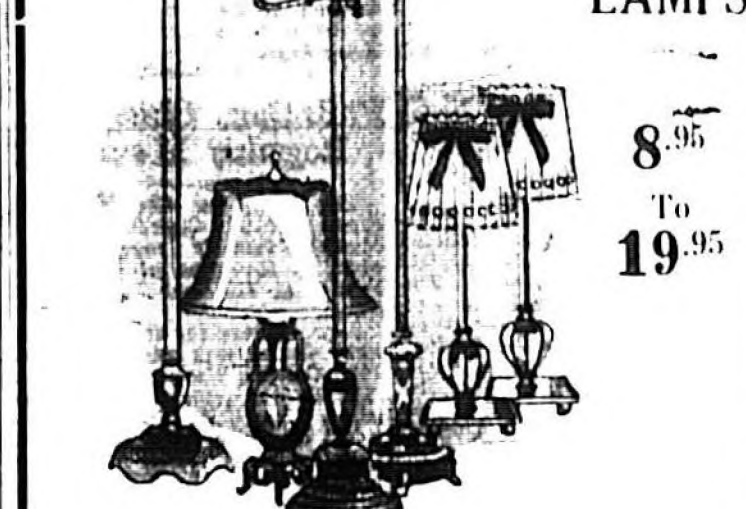

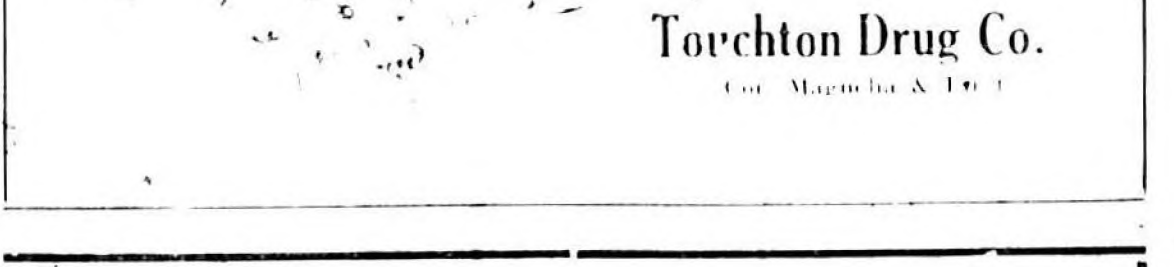

70 Textile Plants Closed As Strike Idles 2,000,000

(Continued From Page One) Washington. Our oil supplies will begin to reach the critical stage by mid-week. Edgar L. Warren, new U.S. conciliation service chief, who arranged transfer of the deadlocked conference from Chicago to Washington, said both he and the secretary believed the oil strike the nation's most critical at the present time.

Warren said Schwelvenbach and he believed "the oil strike is holding up reconversion to a greater extent than any other strike." "It was felt," Warren said in suggesting the move, "that perhaps more progress toward settle-

ment could be made in Washington." The sessions will reconvene there Saturday morning.

Other important labor developments were: **Strike Spreads** 1. The 12-day-old oil strike, involving 32,000 workers and threatening to spread to include 250,000, extended to an eighth state, Louisiana.

2. Secretary Schwelvenbach said the government would not seize oil properties until all conciliation efforts were exhausted. 3. The national total of persons idle because of strikes and shut-downs stood at 370,000. Another 1,500,000 were effected indirectly by the New York building service strike, either by inability to reach offices or refusal to cross picket lines.

4. The bureau of labor statistics reported strikes and lockouts involved 22,000 workers and caused 1,350,000 man-days of idleness in August, when the wave of post-war strikes was starting. This idleness, the bureau said, constituted only "19,100 of one percent of the available working time" in the nation.

Renew Efforts Both management and CIO Oil Workers' union representatives agreed to renew in Washington their efforts to break a three-day deadlock in negotiations to end the strike for a 30 percent wage rate increase.

Warren, who made a surprise entrance into the controversy yesterday, said he had told the union he was sure he could count on no expansion of the strike between now and Saturday. The union made no formal reply.

Shortly before this 109 refinery workers at the Chalmette Petroleum corporation in New Orleans joined the strike. CIO headquarters there said locals in four other plants in the district, with 400 workers had voted

to strike. The added Louisiana to the list of states previously involved—Texas, Ohio, Indiana, Michigan, Illinois, West Virginia and Massachusetts.

"There will be no seizures unless and until there is no longer any hope of settlement by conciliation means," Secretary Schwelvenbach said of the strike through a department official. Other labor department authorities said seizure would take place only if recommended by the army and navy, and in such case might cover only the plants needed to fill military demands.

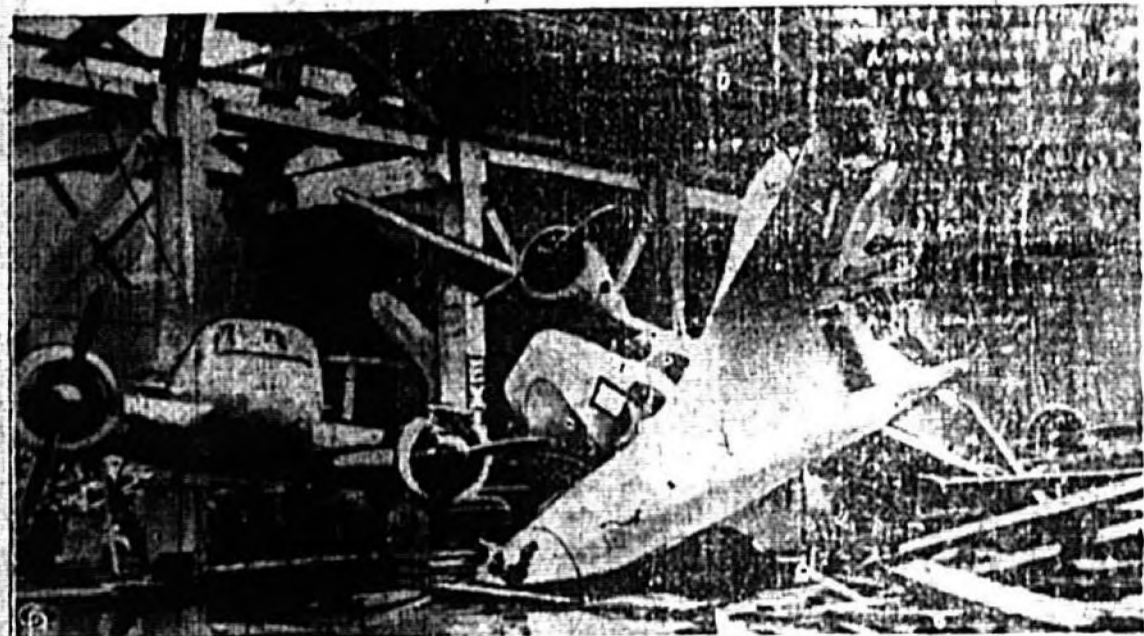
