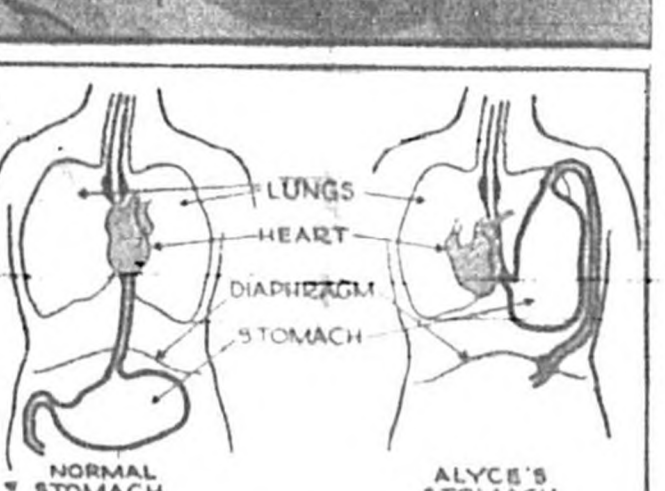


Diagram illustrating the location of the stomach and other internal organs.

Oliver Wendell Holmes

To be a liberal at a time when the great majority see numerous wrongs existing in the social order and are crying out for change, requires unusual powers of discernment or strength of character; but to be a liberal when practically everyone is satisfied with the status quo, when grave abuses go unnoticed by nine out of every ten, when the majority are conservative and the reactionary, then to be a liberal requires not only a penetrating insight into human problems so necessary to properly ferret out social injustices but also what is far rarer, the courage, the will power, and the conscientiousness to stand against the tide. Such a man was Oliver Wendell Holmes. He was called "the great dissenter." He dissented because he was a liberal at a time when the majority were conservative. He dissented because he believed that human rights under our Constitution were superior to property rights, at a time when most people were more interested in the acquisition of property for themselves than they were in the common welfare of the people. Today Mr. Holmes would not be a dissenter either on the Supreme Court or in the great court of public opinion. He would find the vast majority with him.

But there is one respect in which Mr. Holmes, outstanding liberal though he was, might have found himself out of tune with present day trends. He was a staunch believer in state's rights. Though in his youth he fought against the South when it claimed the right to secede from the Union, throughout his long legal career and his thirty years on the Supreme Court bench he sought to uphold the power of local governments and opposed the constant tendency toward federal control and bureaucracy. These liberal political opinions of the welfare of the common man in a country so extensive and diversified as our own.

While it is for his great work as an interpreter of laws that Mr. Holmes will be most remembered, it cannot be overlooked at this time that, as a son of Oliver Wendell Holmes, the writer, he inherited much of his father's literary ability and though most of his work was confined to the law, his literary opinions, his brilliant and makes them worthy of the finest bookshelf. It is also worth remembering that Mr. Holmes, the Supreme Court Justice, the scholar, the gentleman, was once a soldier in the Civil War. President Roosevelt had not overheard him, the picture when he says of Mr. Holmes: "He was a life of great distinction, soldier, scholar, author, teacher, jurist and gallant gentleman, he personified throughout his long career the finest American traditions. With his death America has lost one of its first citizens."

Miami Daily News Starts Federal "Baby Bank" Plan

New Deal Legislation Available To Groups In Any Section Offers Easy Term Credit

MIAMI, Mar. 7.—"As easy to start as a game of bridge—and as sound as Gibraltar," is a description given of the Federal Credit Union banks, sometimes called "baby banks."

In fact you can start on the same procedure. Call in a few dollars any afternoon or evening, but instead of gambling a quarter on each rubber, subscribe it as capital to a "baby bank." And you are on the way to becoming a full-fledged banker under government supervision.

Only a scant handful of groups during the past year have acted under this piece of New Deal legislation, when passed it possible for every worker, no matter how insignificant, to start a cooperative bank, without capital, without assets, but with only the desire to go forward.

These are now almost 100 "baby banks" in full operation and under government charter and the movement is spreading as rapidly that Administration officials in Washington are having difficulty keeping abreast of the flood of applications.

Miami Daily News employees launched such a baby bank three

each week or month by the members, just as the big downtown banks get their money for loans from the depositors. But before this can be done—this business of making money for the stockholders, and through it is still in its swaddling clothes, its success is assured from the start.

Schools T. W. Lawton. The Board had been advised by State Supt. of Schools W. S. Cawthon that if tax collections continue to the end of the term as they have during the past few months, Seminole County may secure at least an additional \$17,000 of state funds.

Supt. Lawton stated that such an event, the county school system would be nearly \$5000 better off than planned. The 1934-35 budget is based on the receipt of \$70,132.72 in state funds for the payment of teachers' salaries, he said. Already nearly \$61,000 has been received for this purpose. The \$17,000 additional will bring the state donation to \$77,042.02, or nearly \$6000 more than was anticipated.

The \$6000 surplus will be carried over to the fall term. Mr. Lawton said to be used in paying part of the salaries of teachers for the first month of the 1935-36 term.

Now, where does the baby bank get money to operate, make loans and earn dividends for the stockholders?

This comes from deposits made by members. The baby bank is a cooperative bank, and its success is assured from the start.

When the charter and by-laws are received from Washington, and the supplies received, the first thing is to call a meeting of the members. They will find that the entire course of procedure is laid out for them.

At the initial meeting (and Daily News employees have already followed this procedure), there is elected a board of directors, who fix the policies, a credit committee, which has authority on granting of loans, and a supervisory committee, whose function is that of a bank examiner.
