# Fatalities caused by excessive speed

Mary Hill was driving 80 mph — more than twice the recommended speed when her BMW slammed into a tree

LAKE MARY — The Florida Highway Patrol released a preliminary report on the double fatality crash Monday afternoon on Markham Woods Road south of the Lake Mary Boulevard intersection.

The report indicates that the driver of the vehicle, Mary L. Hill of Longwood, was traveling at a speed of 80 miles per

hour. The speed limit in that area is 45 miles per hour, and a sign posted near the curve where the wreck occurred warns motorists not to exceed 35 miles per hour. On the report, "exceeding stated speed limit" was listed as the contributing cause.

The crash took the lives of 14year-old Carrie Ann Brown and 13-year-old Amanda J. Hill, daughter of the driver.

Mary Hill was listed in stable

condition at Orlando Regional Medical Center Thursday afternoon. Zachary Rockwell, 14, another passenger in the vehicle was in serious but stable condition at Arnold Palmer Medical Center with a small head concussion.

The FHP diagram of the accident shows the vehicle, traveling south, went around a slight curve, then veered left over the median, then spun to the right where it, "rotated counter-clockwise around a tree and came to final rest on the west shoulder." The tree was just a short distance from a sidewalk.

The Florida Highway Patrol indicated the investigation was continuing in the case.

## State prisoner escapes

Eric M. Chapman walks away from work detail

SANFORD — For the second time in five days, a prison inmate has escaped from his work detail in Sanford. Eric M. Chapman, 28,

escaped from a work detail Thursday afternoon, at the intersection of SR-46 and Airport Boulevard, Chapman, a state prisoner, had been incarcerated at Central Florida Reception Center in Orlando. He was serving a sentence of one year and one day for burglary and grand theft in Seminole County. He was scheduled to be released on

Chapman, a minimum custody inmate, reportedly did not require constant sight supervision by a corrections officer. He was reported missing at 2 p.m. Officers immediately began a search using K-9 units. He had been assigned to a Department of Transportation work detail. As of this morning he was still at large and anyone seeing him is urged to phone 911. Saturday another inmate

The Seminole County Sheriff's Department is searching for a person involved in an armed robbery Wednesday at Ace Cash Express, 6851 U.S. Highway 17-92 in Fern Park.

According to Deputy Keith Weissman, when he responded to a call regarding the incident, he was advised that a white male, five feet ten to six feet tall, placed a plastic box-like container on the county. The store

clerk said he observed a string of some sort, protruding from the box, and described the box as being plastic with a frosty

The victim told the suspect he was closed, but the suspect stated, "I don't think so, give me. the money." The victim thought it was a joke and asked what the box was. The robber said, "In the condition I am in, I will take the both of us. It's an explosive."

The clerk handed over

approximately \$2,000 in cash through the opening in the glass, and dove to the floor, pushing the alarm. The suspect fled the business in an unknown direction.

Crime Scene deputies responded and a composite sketch was made.

The suspect is described as a white male, wearing light colored jeans or khaki pants. He was wearing a beige ball cap

## Code Enforcement Board judges itself and Seminole County

SANFORD — At a recent meeting, the Code Enforcement **Board of Seminole County** voted to dismiss one of its members — Roger Stitt.

Stitt had not met the attendance requirements for the

County Commissioner Dick Van Der Weide, who had appointed Stitt, wasn't aware the Code Enforcement Board could do this. When told it could, Van Der Weide appointed a new Code Enforcement Board member — Bill Fahey.

For the most part, there is little controversy coming from Code Enforcement Board meetings. Seven residents of the county are appointed by county commissioners to serve 3-year terms on the Board. They are not paid for this work.

The current code board members are: Jean Metts (chairman), Tyrus Sheehan, Larry Lawver, Tony Tizzio, Jay Ammon, Bill Fahey and Susan Doerner.

"The Board members form a very unique group — they're more like a set of judges," said County Commissioner Grant Maloy. "They're independent of the County Commission. They review the various code enforcement complaints.

"If a lot needs to be cleaned up - if there are old cars or debris accumulating, the Code Enforcement Board makes the decision," Maloy said. "Is the owner at fault? Does the county have the right to step in? A property owner can appeal the decision to a County Court."

Tony Tizzio, of Casselberry, is one of the Code Enforcement Board members

"This is a judge's job," Tizzio said. "I pride myself on listening to both sides of each case. We're apt to have a little old lady whose children have died and who's yard is a mess. I don't think it's right to hurt anyone like that. Here's where the county should help. We clean it up -- even if it ends up



**DEAR HOLLY:** Thank you for giving women this important reminder, and for giving me the opportunity to reprint these recommendations from the American Cancer Society for

early breast cancer detection. (i) Women age 40 and older should have a screening mam-

mogram every year. (2) Between the ages of 20 and 39, women should have a clinical breast exam by a health professional every three years. At age 40, women should have a breast exam by a health professional every year.

(3) Women age 20 or older should perform a breast selfexam (BSE) every month.

(4) If a change occurs, a woman should see her health provider as soon as possible for evaluation.

The American Cancer Society can provide free information on how to perform a BSE by calling (800) 227-2345. You will be referred to your nearest ACS

## Back pain has many causes

DEAR DR. GOTT: For 20 years, I've suffered back pains that are relieved as soon as I get out of bed. Also, I have chest discomfort that behaves the same way. During the day, I feel 30 years old; at night, I feel 90. What's causing this?

**DEAR READER:** Backache is one of the most common symptoms prompting people to seek medical

comfort from prolonged sitting or standing, sudden movements (such as twisting or straightening), or heavy lifting. Back muscles, like other muscles in the body, can ache and cramp under certain circumstances. Stress and fatigue may lead to back pain, as can fever, flu, arthritis and strenuous activity. Ordinarily, this type of muscular backache can

easily be treated with rest, heat, ibuprofen, massage and gentle stretching exercises. In contrast, back pain can also

result from more serious medical conditions, such as spinal compression fractures (common in patients with osteoporosis) and herniated discs. The intervertebral discs are tough but flexible doughnut-shaped structures that separate the spinal bones. When portions of a disc slip or protrude out of position, they may press against spinal nerves, causing pain that extends down the back into one leg or the other, so-called sciatica. If spinal arthritis is also present, the pain may be

substantially aggravated. Other common causes of back pain include scoliosis (spinal curvature), trauma and spondylolisthesis (forward displacement Of one Verlebra over another).

Treatment for such conditions often requires physical therapy, braces or corsets, modification of activity, or surgery.

Patients with chronic back problems often discover on their own that the pain may be relieved by positioning or movement, and worsened by inactivity (which predisposes the back muscles to contract and cramp). Thus, symptoms may actually increase at night and diminish by day.

From your description, I con-

clude that you suffer from periodic muscle spasms, primarily at night. In my opinion, you should be examined by an orthopedic surgeon, who, after testing you and X-raying your spine, can diagnose the cause of your spasms and suggest treatment. For instance, simple muscle pain might well respond to chiropractic manipulation; arthritis could be helped by anti-inflammatory drugs, such as ibuprofen; a herniated disc may need surgical attention

Finally, I'm not sure what causes your chest pain. Peptic ulcer, hiatal hernia and angina are associated with such pain, so perhaps your orthopedic surgeon may choose to have you tested for these conditions as well. I suspect, however that your chest pain may occur as a 'sympathetic reaction" to back spasm. Therefore, by treating your back problem, the specialist may also relieve your chest discomfort. 

"The recall underway here?" we asked.

"I'm not authorized to say," Kovalick answered.

Firestone hasn't had as much controversy and news coverage since the origin of the tire. Facing 50 lawsuits, 46 deaths, 80 injuries and a federal investigation, the company has hired additional public relations personnel to answer media questions.

Here's what the hired-tire men are saying. Yes, Phase I of the Great Recall is

underway in four states -Florida, Árizona, California and Texas.

Firestone tire recall hits close to home

"That's where the most complaints came from, those four states," my tire source said.

He said tire and service centers were accepting recall customers ten minutes after the Bridgestone/Firestone announcement at 11 a.m. Wednesday, Yes, Florida customers were among the first. Some owners complained, however, they were getting the runaround. Some were told their tires had too many miles on them, and were not covered.

Most of the recalled Firestone ATX, ATX II and Wilderness AT are on Ford Explorers, the

industry's top-selling sport-utility vehicle.



n't happen just as the novel describes. "Left Behind" purports to be a true-tolife account of the rapture - Earth's last days, when believers

will be snatched away from whatever they are doing and taken to "meet the Lord in the sky." Not wanting to

be unprepared, Christians have left instructions on the dashboards of their cars telling passengers what to do if the driver of the car should suddenly be whisked from behind the steering wheel and transported to

The passengers who find themselves in a driverless vehicle are told: "Do not panic. Shut off the ignition and sleer the carto the side of the road." (That actually may not be good advice, since in today's cars

with power steering, when the engine is turned off, so is the power steering.)

The principals in the apocalyptic suspense. thriller by Tim LaHaye and Jerry Jenkins (both born-again Christians) are airline passengers who simply vanish mid-flight. leaving their clothes and bewildered companions behind while chaos extends worldwide

Plagenz St. Paul describes the Bible rapture in his letter to the Thessalonians. The word "rapture" comes from the Latin word meaning to seize or carry off. In the words of St. Paul, "the Lord shall descend from the heaven ... and the dead in Christ shall rise

first. Then we who are alive ... shall be caught up together with them in the clouds and meet the Lord in the air."

In other words, when the end of the world comes, the believers will be snatched away to safety. wherever they are

While "Left Behind" is fiction, there are many weird and unnatural things happening in this scientific age in which there is supposed to be a logical explanation. for everything. An Eastern Airlines jet goes down in the Everglades in Florida in 1972. Among the 101 killed are the pilot and the flight engineer. A few months later, the ghosts of the two crewmen begin to appear on Eastern Airlines planes that are using parts salvaged from the wrecked craft. There was the time when a flight attendant, making a routine head. count in the first-class section. before takeoff, apparently discovered she had one more passenger than she could account. for Then she spotted an Eastern Airlines pilot in uniform in one of the seats. That, she assured herself, was the reason for the

discrepancy. "I beg your pardon," said the flight attendant, "I don't have you on my list."

The pilot didn't respond. The shaky flight attendant called the flight captain. When he leaned down to address the uniformed pilot, he turned white



Hudson led the Clippers in assists 25 times, in steals 10 times and in scoring on three occasions. He was waived by the Clippers on March 27.




