Policies of the federal land banks in refinancing farm debts were explained by Henry Johnson, a member of the senior loan committee of the Columbia, S. C., land bank at this conference.

Views on the general farm credit situation were offered by Dr. G. W. Fisher, noted economist of Raleigh, N. C., who is admitted to being head of the department of agriculture in the North Carolina State College and a member of his state's tax commission, is serving as executive secretary of the North Carolina Farm Debt Adjustment Commission.

"I intend to make Italy great," Benito Mussolini said, as he inaugurated perhaps the most sweeping peace-time mobilization in history, "through training millions of young men."

Actual military training begins at the age of 21 years, while compulsory training continues for 10 years.
