# Bandit Robs Store, Threatens Employees

A revolver-waving bandit robbed a Sanford grocery store Wednesday night after threatening to kill an assistant manager and cashier.

The robber, described by the victims as a white male in his late 20s, about 6 feet tall with a tan complexion, long sideburns and a goatee kept telling Donn Schunk and Rita West he would shoot them because he had nothing to lose, and repeatedly commented on "how much fun he was having."

Police believe he escaped in a yellow Chevrolet Malibu. Schunk and Mrs. West, employees of Food Fair, 240 S. Park Ave., were forced at gunpoint to open a safe and remove a large amount of money, and then were bound with adhesive tape.

The store had closed for the night, and employees were preparing to leave, when the man came to the door under the pretenses that he had lost his wallet earlier and had heard that it had been found.

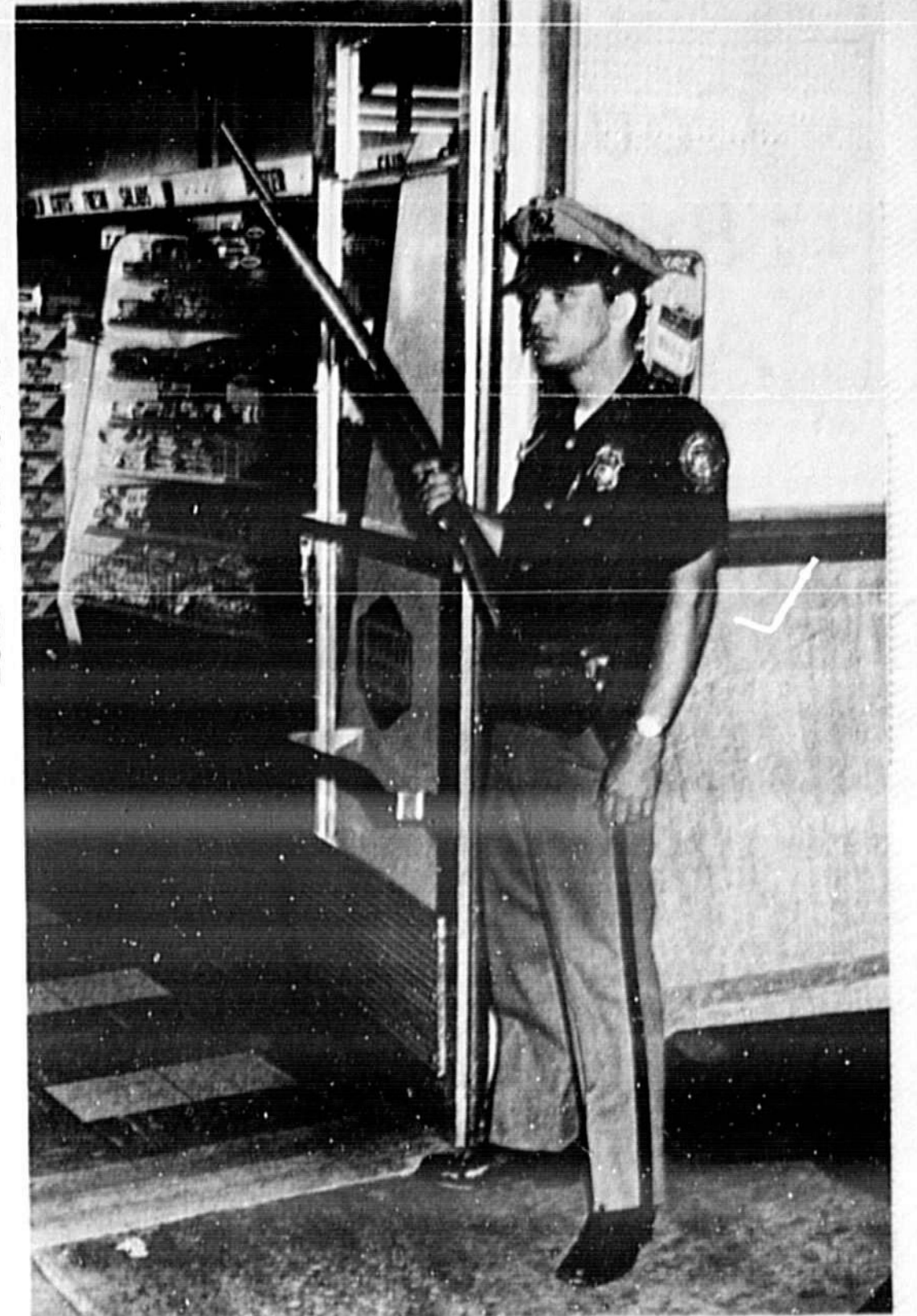
He entered the store and walked toward the office, where Schunk was standing outside the door to the office. After employees told him they knew nothing of the wallet, he pulled the gun and told them it was a holdup. He got several thousand dollars.

He then forced the two to go inside the office, making Mrs. West tie up Schunk with tape. Mrs. West was then tied, and the man apparently walked out the front door, according to Lt. William Lykens, investigating officer.

Meanwhile, two tagboys had witnessed the robbery, one of them Lykens' son. Using a ladder, Billy Lykens and Jeff Jackson managed to go up above the ceiling and escape out the back. They ran to a nearby service station to notify police. Within a minute after the call, Patrolman Bill Mager was on the scene.

Police surrounded the store, thinking the robber was still inside. Mrs. West managed to free her hands, and then freed Lykens.

### Gasoline Rationed By Sears Roebuck

MIAMI (AP) — Sears Roebuck & Co. is rationing gasoline sales in 11 south Florida outlets and in two Tennessee cities because of a critical shortage of fuel supplies, company spokesmen say.

Motorists patronizing service stations operated by the department store chain are limited to a 10-gallon maximum purchase at Sears pumps from Palm Beach to Key West.

The restrictions were imposed Tuesday, said David Faulkner, community affairs director for Sears South Florida district. A company spokesman in the store's Chicago, Ill., headquarters said similar rationing was underway in Memphis and Nashville, Tenn., but not nationwide.

"We're on an allocation from the supplier and gasoline sales have increased," said Faulkner. "So before the situation became critical and we were forced to close stations, the decision was made to limit purchases."

Sears' stores in Florida are provided by the Marathon Oil Co. of Findlay, Ohio, but recently the supplier informed Sears no extra gasoline was available.

"Marathon doesn't have any more to sell," said Faulkner, adding the shortage wasn't created by the low retail price of the gas.

A survey of several Miami area stations revealed Sears regular gasoline was priced as much as five cents below competitors' prices.

Faulkner said few complaints had been registered about the rationing but one service station employee said there had been some "grumbling."

"But there's nothing that can be done about it," the attendant said.

### POWs Set Up Own 'Military'

Complete staffs were drawn up, Wells said, along the lines of a military organization. Things went up channels and down channels.

"This helped us keep our minds busy, helped us to do something and maybe this helped us to maintain our will and good attitude toward the military."

Wells said such prison cell had a public address speaker and the North Vietnamese "pumped" a lot of garbage through that thing; plus, for a time, we heard the Voice of Vietnam aimed at soldiers in South Vietnam.

Wells said North Vietnam broadcasts to the POWs were discontinued in June.

American prisoners of war in North Vietnam set up their own, highly organized, military-style commands despite objections from their captors and centralized on mental and physical exercises to keep themselves fit, former POWs disclosed today. There were some attempts by the Communists to brainwash, but they were ineffective, the men indicated.

A picture of life in the prison camps began to emerge as the last of the known prisoners were freed. The men released earlier had declined to comment on their conditions for fear of jeopardizing the safety of those still in captivity.

### Kimbrough Questions Longwood

LONGWOOD — Mayor Eugene Jacques declined comment today on a letter sent to the city by a county commissioner questioning the contiguity of Lake Ruth South Subdivision on SR 427.

District County Commissioner John Kimbrough Tuesday mailed a letter to Council Chairman William Klotz, enclosing a copy of a plat map showing the location of the subdivision as well as a copy of an ordinance annexing it to the city.

"As you can see, this property does not appear to be contiguous to the city limits of Longwood," Kimbrough said.

"Please advise the board of county commissioners if there are other annexations that may affect this particular parcel of land to make it contiguous."

Jacques told The Herald... the city are apparently involved in litigation with the State of Florida over road annexation. I have not received Kimbrough's letter and I will not comment on it at this time.

"But there seems to be here and in other cities a question of whether certain annexed properties are within the territorial limits of the city before making any comment I would like to discuss this matter with the city attorney (S. Joseph Davis Jr.) since he is representing us on any road annexation."

The subdivision is on the east side of SR 427. The city some months ago annexed a parcel across the highway from Lake Ruth South to be developed into a trailer park. At the time, Councilman E. E. Williamson questioned whether the trailer park was contiguous and was told by the attorney Lake Ruth South provided the link with the city.

The subdivision, according to city map, is not land contiguous since it is separated from other city territory by a sliver of county land. The mayor's comments appear to indicate the city will claim contiguity by virtue of price annexation of the highway.

The city currently is involved in a suit brought by Attorney Robert Shevin challenging the contiguity of the Shadow Hill subdivision on the Longwood-Markham Road being built by Tim-Tec Development. Since the suit was filed, the city annexed a parcel of land which the city fathers claim now makes the Tim-Tec tract contiguous.

Contiguity is one of the annexation requirements under the city charter and state law.

### Joe Davis To Remain In Longwood
