### Nation's Elderly To Reap Benefits By September

WASHINGTON (UPI) The Johnson administration hopes to have the medicare bill signed into law by July 31 with the nation's elderly beginning to reap the dividends in September. Senate passage of the leg-

islation by a 68-21 vote last Friday assured a major congressional victory for the President and enactment this session of the measure, a far - reaching plan to provide medical care for 19 million Americans 65 and over and to raise all Social Security benefits. The House passed a sir lar bill April 8.

It now goes to a House Senate conference committee, which will work out a compromise version, starting Wednesday. The administra-tion was confident the dif-The biggest difference stems from the fact that the House bill would cost \$6 billion to provide the expanded Social Security benefits and the medical health care features of the program, while the Senate measure would

cost \$7.5 billion. Senate spokesmen privately conceded that many of the extra features written into the Senate bill will be eliminated and the final measure will be closer to the House vers-
