Promoter Predicts Compulsory Sale of Planes in Show

NEW YORK, Dec. 31.—(INS)—The New York Aircraft Show to be held by Aviators Post No. 743 American Legion at Grand Central Palace in February will produce more actual sales of aircraft than any other aircraft show ever held is the prediction of Thomas L. Hill, President of The American Society for Promotion of Aviation.

Hill bases his prediction upon the fact that there is at present considerable over-production in the aircraft industry especially in the light airplane class and that manufacturers will be ready to make liberal discounts.

On the other hand recent surveys by the Society show that there are many prospects among individuals and flying clubs for a light airplane selling at a reasonable price, and that the wide distribution of light airplanes in the early spring will bring many sales to the aircraft manufacturer of the summer of 1930.

One of the newer type light planes to be shown at the show is an all metal low wing monoplane which is reported to have established a record of 335 miles an hour, equipped with a sixty horsepower motor. This plane will sell at approximately \$1500.
