the tale of a royal Iranian gift. "You may have put me in the position of being able to say (to the President) 'let's cut out the s-'," Colson went on.

"You don't want to practice blackmail on the President You don't want to put yourself in the same position as these other people have, Chuck," said Bast. The tape purred soundlessly for a moment.

Footnote: Colson's brief threat to blackmail the President was clearly not to save himself. He had already agreed in writing to plead guilty to obstruction of justice. In any case, he quietly informed Presidential Counsel Fred Buzhardt of the Iranian report and did no more about it. CIA sources said the Colson campaign

Fight 'Just Begins' On Abortion Clinic

By CHRIS NELSON Herald Staff Writer

The battle over a proposed woman's hospital which critics claim will be an "abortion mill" has just begun, according to a developer's representative. Former Seminole County planner

David Farr, representing Winter Park and Titusville Dr. Samuel Barr, Tuesday prompted applause from a packed county commission chamber audience by announcing Barr had withdrawn his zoning request for a 10-acre hospital site at Dike and Tuskawilla Roads. However, no sooner had the op-

ponents - including church organizations, doctors and civic groups — trooped from commission chambers when Farr told reporters "the issue is far from over," and said Barr "is more enthusiastic than ever" in the wake of what he said

was a medical council endorsement

of certain abortion services. Last week's County Health Planning Council's veto of Barr's first plans, by just one vote after nearly four hours of debate, wound up advocating the need for abortion services during the first three months, Farr said.

After negative recommendations by Seminole Memorial Hospital Administrator Robert Besserer and others who said Barr's planned obstetrics wing was economically unjustified, Farr said Barr will "reevaluate" his 50-bed proposal and will probably scale down the plans to 15 to 25 beds. Medical council approval is vital if

the hospital is to qualify for state and federal grants, Farr said, adding Barr will reapproach the council when his new plans are ready Both Farr and Commission
