Hospital Care

The puzzling fact that mortality from appendicitis is greater in the United States and Canada than in European countries is brought to light by an analysis of the death rates of this disease made by the Statistical Bureau of the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company. For the past few years the death rate has averaged around 11 to 15 per 100,000 in the two American countries, whereas in Europe it ranged from 3 in Spain to 12 in Switzerland. Furthermore, relatively more die from appendicitis in America than a quarter of a century ago, despite wider knowledge of the pathology of the disease, improved operative technique and better hospital facilities.

The highest death rates from appendicitis, more than 20 per 100,000 of population, are found in the states of Montana, Idaho, Wyoming, Nevada, Utah and Colorado. The Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, which is the chief sponsor of this study, points out that the chief explanation for these high rates here is the fact that nearly all of these states are sparsely inhabited and that population centers containing hospitals are few and far between. They all are in the mountains.
