Soviets Declare Red Armies Stand Firm Before Stalingrad

Hittler Claims Nazis Capture Further Heights In Area From Stubborn Fog

(Associated Press)

Hittler's field headquarters today asserted German troops have captured "further sub-tilly - defensed heights" within the fortified area of Stalingrad while Soviet dispatches declared that Red Armies are firmly regrouped after the re-inforced Nazi troops opened a dangerous new salient west of the great Volga steel city.

Once again Marshal Timoshen-ko's forces rallied in the critical hour. In the western Caucasus the situation remained acute.

The extent of the German gain on the Stalingrad front was not disclosed, but it was indicated that the Germans had shifted their weight into a direct frontal attack on the city after being stalled northwest and southwest of the city.

The Russians said their counter-attacks in the Mordovia area of the Caucasian foothills forced the Germans to retreat.

Fighting on the northwestern approaches to Stalingrad was not mentioned in the midnight communiqué. It was in this area that Soviet troops were reported yesterday to have battered their positions in a series of counter-attacks.

Southwest of Stalingrad the Red army beat off a series of German attacks, one unit destroying eight of 80 Nazi tanks which attacked a Soviet artillery battery.

A surprise Red army counter-attack in the Mordovia area of the Caucasian foothills forced the Germans from an isolated foothill position and captured the headquarters of a German unit," the communiqué said.


