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De Pinedo's Death Revives Stories Of His Exile, Love Affairs, Political Fights

NEW YORK, Sept. 14.— The tragic death of Gen. Francesco de Pinedo, one-time air hero of all Italy, revives stories of his virtual exile from his native land since 1922. Love or politics— probably both— tore the ill-fated fighter from the pedestal of fame and sent him into comparative obscurity and eventually to his death. It was in an effort to restore his lost prestige that de Pinedo planned a solo non-stop flight from New York to Baghdad, a distance of 6000 miles. His overland plane failed to take off and the "Italian Lindbergh" died in his blazing ship.
