Middle East Negotiators In Washington For Talks

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Egyptian, Israeli and American negotiators are gathered in Washington to try to reach at least an appearance of renewed momentum in the stalled Palestinian autonomy talks. The negotiators were invited to Washington by President Carter to work out procedures for the negotiations, which failed to achieve agreement on the future rule of the territories occupied by Israeli forces since 1967.

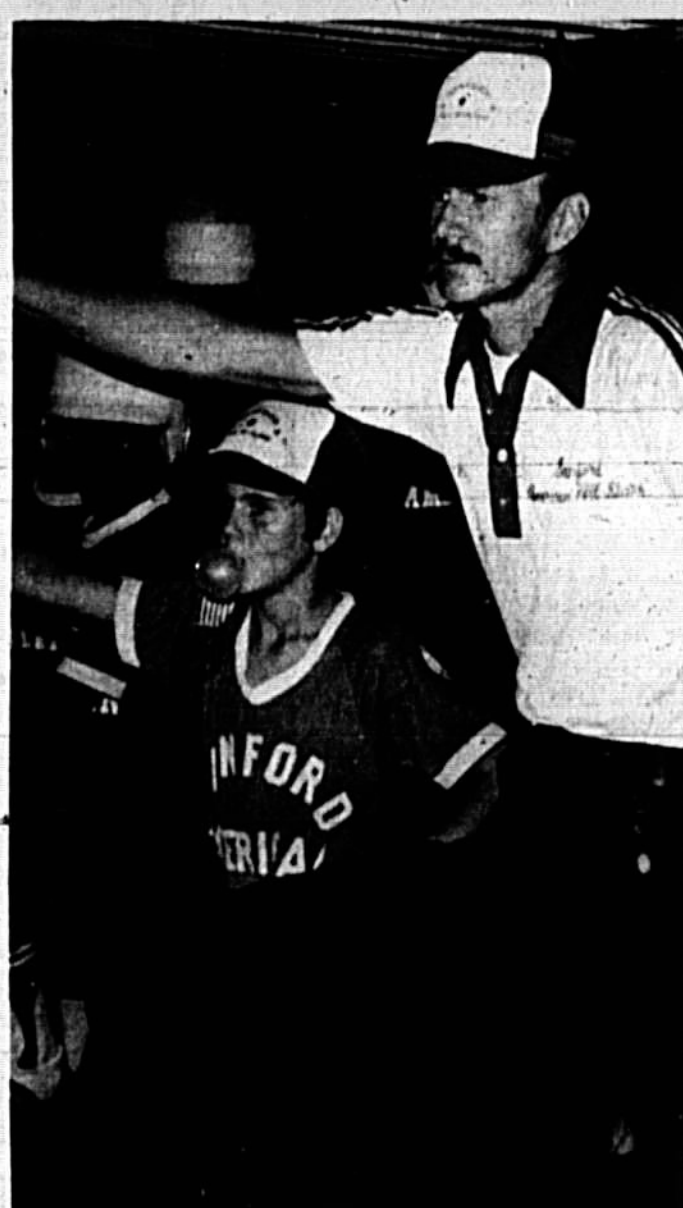

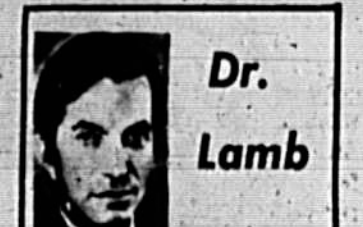








DEAR DR. LAMB - About a year ago I went on the Scarsdale diet and went from 120 pounds to 110. Since then I've kept my weight steady around 110 pounds. Within the last two months I've begun to lose even more and I'm now at 100 pounds. My body has lost all of its elasticity, especially in my arms and breasts. Is there anything I can do to improve my body's firmness and elasticity?



You might also want to know that even if you diet enough protein in your diet if you don't have enough calories that protein will be used for energy. That means the protein is not available to rebuild the normal wear and tear of body structures or to grow new muscles.

People who are on a sensible diet because they really do have a problem with being overweight can do a lot to prevent loss of muscle and sagging skin by using an exercise program while they're dieting. If your diet is too restricted and particularly if you're not exercising, you will lose muscle tissue. The classic examples are the prisoners of war in concentration camps that came back with emaciated bodies.

Being overweight is a serious health problem. Undernutrition is another serious health problem most often occurring in women on fat diets. A lot of people who go on fat diets are literally on starvation or semi-starvation diets that are really health wreckers.
