(Continued from Page One) not exist any other place in the County which is or could immediately be made, suitable and adequate for the needs of the hospital or from which it could effectually render its service for the essential health needs of the people of the County.

It appears, meanwhile, that it should be possible to make suitable health needs of both the Naval Base personnel and the County population by permitting the hospital to temporarily continue in its present location, it was stated.

Following an appeal by C. A. Maddy of the Fellowship Foundation that the institution be charged no more rent for the occupation of barracks at the Naval Air Station in view of the order to vacate in the near future, the Commission agreed to abate the rents due to the personal problems of elderly persons finding adequate living facilities.

Mr. Maddy added that the place now secured by the foundation on the lakefront were received. One of these was presented by W. R. Williams in behalf of Cecil Ozier, Illinois developer. The other application was from John Gray, New York developer, whose option on the property had expired. The Commission deferred action on the matter pending inquiry into the financial status of the applicants.

The lakefront terminal financing came up for discussion and in order to clear the way for bond financing of the \$350,000 project the Commission passed a resolution rescinding its former action in accepting an R. F. C. commitment.

We landed just 10 miles down the beach from the Am-gansett beachhead, at the deactivated Mecox Coast Guard station, sold by federal authorities to a beach club after the last war. "The Nazis did not, but we did land and carry a trunk that might have held an atom bomb, and we stowed it carefully right under the Times building in the heart of Manhattan."

The story explained there was no accurate information available as to the size of an A-bomb, but the experiment visualized that a bomb could be carried in a small trunk.

The three staffers, Kirk Prier, former merchant marine second mate Bob Hollingsworth, former merchant marine chief radio operator, and Richard Morseman, former photographer's mate in the Navy and Newsday's photo editor, set out from Lake Montauk aboard a seagoing diesel trawler. They were to keep a rendezvous off the Mecox station, 25 miles east of Montauk, at 1:30 A. M.

When the skipper, Capt. Knowles (Boony) Smith, Jr., a Coast Guard veteran and Montauk party boat captain, sighted three long flashes from a nocturnal light, he headed for the beach. Five hundred yards off shore, he launched the raft, with the three staffers and the trunk.

The light was flashed by Pfeifle, who had parked his car behind the Mecox station. During the landing morseman took pictures with infra-red equipment, and regular flash light equipment.
