Governor Martin Swamped By Applications For Post Left Vacant By R. L. Eaton

TALLAHASSEE, Fla., Mar. 1.—Calling attention to the multitude of applications that flooded into his office within a comparatively few hours after the death of State Railroad Commissioner R. L. Eaton at Monticello Sunday night, Governor John W. Martin said today that it was improbable that he would fill the vacancy until after the 1927 session of the state legislature and requested that applications for the post cease coming into his office, at least until after the body of Commissioner Eaton has been interred.

Governor Martin declared that he thought it was the height of unfairness for office-seekers to wire, telephone, and mail applications for the position made vacant by the death of the commissioner even before his funeral arrangements had been made.

"There is no need to send in applications or endorsements for positions left vacant due to the death of an official," Governor Martin said.

"I, as governor of the state, have traveled over it from one end to the other and know Florida and its people and the right persons for positions left vacant. It is my business to know these things."

"Endorsements from applicants for the position left vacant by Mr. Eaton will do the sender no good."

Beautifulization Campaign To Open March 30 And Lasts For Year; 100 Additional Entrants Are Now Forecast

Thirty entries have been received for the Sanford Herald Home Beautifulization Contest, which begins March 30 and is to continue for one year from that date, according to an announcement made today by officials of the Woman's Club, under whose auspices the contest is to be conducted.

Photographs have been made of each home entry and these have been filed for reference at the close of the contest. Preparations for handling entries from at least an additional hundred home owners are being made by the club.

The contest is to be officially opened on the opening day for the annual Flower Show of the Woman's Club, which is to be held at the club on March 30. Entries to that date will be accepted but some will be received thereafter. When the entry is made, a photograph of the home and grounds is to be taken immediately. At the close of the contest another photograph is to be made and the improvement selected.

There are to be four prizes. In the new homes class, there are to be prizes for homes on grounds of more than 75 feet and for less than 75 feet. In the old homes class the same judging is to prevail.

The most improvement in planting and exterior decorating of the homes, and the most improvements shown in the beautifulization of the old homes are to represent the two major classes.

Officials of the Woman's Club have urged club members to enter for prizes. In order that all possible progress may be made during the contest period. Much progress toward home beautifulization has already been made, they say, and entries in the contest have begun to show proof that Sanford home owners are taking pride in the appearance, and interest in the upkeep, of their homes and grounds.

Applications to enter may be made with any official of the club.

CONGRESS MAY TAKE UP FIGHT ON OIL LEASES

Friends Of Doherty Expected To Present Demand For 12 Millions, Alleged To Have Been Spent By E. L. Doherty

Court Rules It Has No Right To Fix Sum

Sinclair Will Suffer Large Loss, Friends Say, If Teapot Dome Lease Is Ended

WASHINGTON, March 1.—The celebrated oil lease which ex-secretary of the interior Albert B. Fall made to companies of Edward L. Doherty and Harry F. Sinclair will become the center of a new fight in future Congresses, it appeared today.

Friends of Doherty are expected to present a demand to Congress for repayment of \$12,000,000 which Doherty's companies spent on oil storage tanks at the Teapot Dome, Hawaii, naval base, and for oil actually furnished the navy.

The Supreme Court, in its sweeping ruling on the Doherty lease to the Elk Hill, naval oil reserve on the ground of "fraud and illegality," held that the action of Congress in paying the money was not a legislative act.

"Whatever their usefulness or value," said the court, referring to expenditures at Teapot Dome, "it is not for the courts to decide whether any of these things are needed or should be retained or used by the United States. Such questions are for the determination of Congress."

The court's ruling showed that Doherty's companies claimed \$11,786,928.12 from the government not including recent interest charges. Of this more than \$7,000,000 was expended upon Teapot Dome oil storage tanks.

Should the high court, as many legal experts now predict, also set aside the Teapot Dome lease to the Mammoth Oil Company, Sinclair will face a big loss.

Final Rites Held For Robert Eaton at Monticello Home

MONTICELLO, Fla., Mar. 1.—(INS)—Funeral services were held today for R. L. Eaton, state railroad commissioner, who died Sunday night.

The services were held from the residence with Rev. R. P. Johnson officiating, interment taking place in the family plot. A delegation from Tallahassee attended.

Eaton was a native of Georgia but had lived in Florida for 39 years. He was elected state railroad commissioner after serving for a number of years as state labor inspector.

Eaton, 55, died at his home Sunday night from a sudden heart attack induced by diabetes.

ATLANTA, Mar. 1.—(INS)—Former Warden Albert B. Hart of Atlanta Penitentiary was just inside the prison today.

JILTED HUSBAND HELD FOR ATTACK ON HIS BROTHER

Edward Carrington, Wealthy Publisher, Said To Have Attacked Campbell Carrington Over 'Affair' With His Wife

NEW YORK, Mar. 1.—(INS)—Edward C. Carrington, 55-year-old millionaire publisher of Chicago, was arrested today in the city club and booked up in a police station on a charge of assaulting his brother Campbell Carrington, 53, a wealthy New York lawyer, last night.

Campbell Carrington is defendant in a \$1,000,000 suit for alleged alienation of affections of Edward Carrington's wife.

Campbell Carrington, his face and head battered, staggered into the Hotel Ansonia and said he had been assaulted by a man with a razor. He was sent to Polyclinia hospital.

Detectives arrested Edward Carrington in the city club, where he was in bed. A charge of felonious assault was lodged against him.

Edward Carrington is said to have a broken up that his brother was going out with Edward's wife. Accompanied by a friend he hurried to her home on West 74th Street to investigate. The friend said as they approached the door, Campbell emerged. Then, according to the friend, the brothers "went to it."

The allegation of affectional alienation came as a sequel to a divorce suit in the Chicago courts in which Edward Carrington and his wife made charges and counter-charges against each other. Papers filed in the suit charged that Mrs. Carrington had been unfaithful to her husband. Carrington is unmarried.

Edward Carrington is president of the Encyclopaedia Americana Inc. He has been active in politics.

400 People Attend Dedication Of New School Last Night

Amended Divorce Petition To Name Co-Respondent In Mrs. Chaplin's Suit For A Divorce From Famous Mate

Charges Not To Be Modified, Says Lawyer

Exhaustive Probe Conducted In Chaplin's Life As Part Of Tax Suit By Government

LOE ANGRILES, March 1.—(INS)—A well known Hollywood motion picture actress will be named as co-respondent in the amended divorce complaint of Lita Grey Chaplin against her famous husband, Charles Chaplin, film comedian, Lyndel L. Young, attorney for Mrs. Chaplin, told International News Service today. The attorney, however, would not divulge the actress' name.

Young's statement today was the first he has made in which he stated without qualification that Mrs. Chaplin would make a co-respondent.

"Not only will Mrs. Chaplin make a co-respondent," the attorney declared, "but she will not retract or modify in the slightest degree the previous charges she has made against her husband."

WASHINGTON, March 1.—(INS)—Charles Chaplin's meteoric flight to fame from the slums of London in a pinnacle of film-comedy success is being written into the records of the Treasury Department.

Special federal investigators have been sent to New York and Los Angeles to conduct an exhaustive probe of Chaplin's affairs in order that his federal tax liability may be determined. It was learned today.

Chaplin already is under bond of nearly a million dollars to meet a huge tax assessment levied by the Bureau of Internal Revenue, immediately after the sensational divorce suit was started against the film funny man by Lita Gray Chaplin.

The government investigation probably will require several months before it is going into very detail of the comedian's business and investments, and income from various sources.

RUTH WILL GET WHAT HE WANTS, WALSH ASSERTS

Col. Jake Ruppert Cannot Let Rumbino Go, Both From Financial And Competitive Point Of View, Says Walsh

NEW YORK, Feb. 25.—(INS)—There being virtually no more Williams available to push into the abyss, George Babe Ruth combed the marcel out of eyebrows that Hollywood had learned to love and respect an today was hastening east to straighten out the last misunderstanding.

Col. Jacob Ruppert, who employs George at such times as he is not occupied with his art, naturally supposed that he was ready to return, sent him a contract for \$52,000, and then turned his thoughts to something important.

Probably he wouldn't have had it happen for the world, if he knew that George was going to get dissatisfied. But it is too late now, for it seems that George got that way, pronto and without a moment's warning.

In his letter to the Colonel, made public on Saturday night, he intimates rather persistently that he would like to get \$100,000 a year for the next two years.

If either of that pair got what he's popularly supposed to have received, Ruth's demand is almost moderate.

This tempestuous "issue," this show down between owner and player, then, is a laugh. The Yankees, from both financial and competitive standpoints, cannot start the season without Ruth. He is the ball club.

The club wouldn't even start its southern exhibition tour without him, for the entire trip is predicated on his drawing ability and the entire expense of the southern invasion cleared off, with a fat profit showing, as a result of that young man's appeal to the fans.
